Annual Argentario ProAm in Tuscany in May Taking Final Few Bookings!

Tuscany, Italy, March 2018: The annual International ProAm staged at the Argentario Golf Resort & Spa (www.argentarioresort.com) which this year takes place on May 19 & 20 is taking the final few bookings for this popular event hosted at one of Tuscany's top golf resorts!

The Stay & Play package for the event includes the two-day, 36 hole medal competition playing in fourballs, three nights in a Design Bedroom with buffet breakfast, a Welcome dinner with drinks, a practice round with complimentary balls on the driving range, attendance at the Awards Ceremony as well as access to the 5-star luxury spa and wellness centre, sauna, Turkish bath, indoor and outdoor swimming pools, Kneipp circuit, gym and tennis courts.

The event is commissionable at 10% to all tour operators and golf professionals who book a team of four players comprising one professional and three amateurs. In addition the golf pro will receive complimentary accommodation, attendance at the Welcome Dinner and the chance to secure some of the Euros 10,000 prize fund for professionals.

The rate per golfer starts from Euros 630 sharing a double room whilst the rate for a non-golfer in a double room starts from Euros 370.



A member of Design Hotels, the Argentario Golf Resort & Spa is located on the Monte Argentario promontory in the picturesque Maremma region of Italy and offers all the charm of a Tuscan hideaway with sleek, modern design, state-of-the-art facilities and exceptional service.

The par 71, 6,218 metre golf course, designed by Italian architect David Mezzacane and professional golfer Badlovino Dassù and several holes were subsequently shaped by Brian Jorgensen, is noted for its panoramic views of the Orbetello Lagoon, Tyrrhenian Sea and surrounding Mediterranean topography.

It is however a deceptively varied and technically-challenging layout. The undulating front nine runs in and out of cork-oak woods showcasing local flora and fauna whilst the back nine meanders gently through romantic, centuries-old olive groves at the foothills of Monte Argentario.

The course is characterized by small, fast-paced greens, a host of intimidating water hazards running alongside several holes and tricky, rolling fairways reminiscent of a links layout. More often than not, a refreshing sea breeze cools down the Tuscan sun though adds an extra challenge to game management which, on this course, requires a combination of accuracy and power.

The well-equipped Golf Academy features the TrackMan IIIe simulator, the latest-generation platform for analyzing your swing and a driving range whilst in-house professionals, Emanuele Canonica and Paolo de Salvatore, are on hand at certain times of the year to give golf lessons.

After golf, gastronomic delights created by chef Riccardo Cappelli await guests in the Dama Dama Restaurant. The cuisine is based on the flavours and colours of the local terrain with dishes prepared using authentic produce from small, carefully-selected local farms and, at certain times of the year, directly from the hotel's vegetable garden and orchard whilst a range of local wines are available to accompany all meals.

Argentario is easily accessed from Rome Fiumicino Airport by car in just an hour and a half whilst Rome Ciampino and Pisa are just over two hours away.
